Requirements:

- Must be between the ages of 15-29 years old
- Must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident
 - *International students or work/visitor visa holders are not eligible*
- Must have a valid SIN
- Available for the entire duration of Camp (July 6 – August 14)
- Available as of late June for team meetings and program planning
- Able to work 30-35 hrs/week for up to 6 weeks (Monday to Friday)

Key Responsibilities:

Program Related:

- Plan, lead and actively participate in daily Arts or Sports or Islamic Studies related summer camp activities
- Set up and facilitate games, crafts and group activities
- Provide a fun, safe and meaningful environment for participants
- Assist in the scheduling/planning of field trips and outdoor activities
- Encourage participant involvement through motivation, enthusiasm and positive reinforcement

Supervisor and Safety:

- Supervise participants and ensure their well-being at all times
- Monitor camp environment to maintain safe and organized activity spaces
- Oversee participants during transitions, free time and lunch periods
- Follow all camp safety procedures and report any concerns to leadership staff

Role Modelling & Support:

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- Create and maintain a positive environment for all participants, volunteers and parents/guardians
- Demonstrate a positive attitude and serve as a strong role model for participants
- Promote respectful behaviour, teamwork and inclusion among participants

Team Collaboration:

- Work collaboratively with other counsellors, volunteers, co-ordinator and camp staff
- Support the overall delivery of camp programming and daily operations

Qualifications:

- Possess some experience working/volunteering with children in a camp, school or recreational setting is an asset
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills and ability to take initiative
- Ability to work well within a team environment
- Energetic, responsible and able to engage children in a group setting
- First aid and CPR certification is an asset (or willingness to obtain)
